Additionally, 100% of students achieved a C or better on theory signature assignments in all 3 didactic courses. Although the benchmark was exceeded, the department acknowledges the need to revise signature assignments to increase rigor and improve program quality. A draft of newly proposed assignments has been uploaded with this report. The proposed assignments will be reviewed and voted on by faculty during the Winter 2024 semester. New benchmarks will be established.
